FLAMENCO AND SPANISH DANCE:

From 1998 to 2001 he participated in various "Zarzuelas" (Spanish Operetta) in the Gran Teatro de Córdoba: "KATIUSKA", "GIGANTESY CABEZUDOS" or "LA PARRANDA", among others, choreographed by the Head of Department of Flamenco at the "Luis del Rio" Conservatory, Inmaculada Aguilar.

In 2002 enters the corps de ballet of the NATIONAL BALLET OF SPAIN, directed by Elvira de Andrés.

After a stint in the National Ballet of Spain is required by ANTONIO MARQUEZ for his Company, acting along the entire national territory and in different countries (Portugal, Japan, Brazil, Italy, Turkey, Israel, Switzerland, Hungary, etc.).

Since 2006 he was Soloist of the same company.

He has also collaborated with the Company SUITE ESPAÑOLA on several of his performances in theatres in Spain and Russia.

At the same time, and since 2005, he works with Yoko Komatsubara's Company in multiple shows on various cities in Japan, China and Korea.

With the same company, he performs in the EXPO-2008 Zaragoza as Guest Artist for the Japanese delegation. Since then, he collaborates assiduously with Yoko Komatsubara either as dance soloist or as teacher.
